We tabled school contribution amounts until a later meeting.

Basket Raffle: Kathy—currently \$365.00 for this year. Mike and Holly contributed \$50.00 toward the fund.

Group discussion on any newsletter edits.

We agreed on an 80" projection screed from Best Buy for \$115.00.

Next meeting June 4 or June 11, at which time we need to discuss the creation and duplication of the Banquet program for this year.

Banquet details are in place, with possible further discussion with Nora regarding correcting some issues with last year's dinner. Scott and Michelle will be advised of final proof of newsletter. Quick follow-up on last month's "Fore Brothers" golf report—Daron indicated that the \$307.00 was insurance on the \$20K Hole-in One Contest.
